Grammarian	The responsibilities of the grammarian are to introduce new words to members, comment on the language used during the course of the meeting, and to provide examples of good grammar and word usage.
	The grammarian also counts ums, ahs and filler words and reports their findings

Before the meeting

Choose a Word of the Day and add it to Easy Speak. The goal is to introduce new words that members could use during the course of the meeting. Adjectives tend to be the easiest to incorporate into speech, followed by verbs and lastly nouns.

Coordinate with the Chair in selecting the meeting theme. A word of the day to compliment the theme is a great way to incorporate the theme into the meeting.

Ask the General Evaluator for any advice or recommendations for evaluating language use and feedback.

Create a visual aid for the word of the day. Have the word, definition and usage sample on a piece of standard letter paper (horizontal orientation) for the lecturn.

Upon arrival at the meeting

Place the visual aid at the front of the room for everyone to see. A standard letter size sheet will fit directly onto the podium

During the meeting

Describe the role of the Grammarian
Present the Word of the Day when called upon by the Chair.
"This evenings word of the day is ______.
It is defined as... / It means... / It's definition is...
Use it in a sentence
When we hear the word of the day we will.... (typically knock on the table / snap fingers / something interesting)"

Record the use of ums, ahs and filler words Listen for good or interesting use of language and record the instances in the grammarian's log Listen for uses of the Word of the Day and record who used it Report your findings at the end of the meeting when called upon by the General Evaluator
