As Toastmasters it's important that we become good reflective listeners. The Quizmaster tests everyone's listening skills by creating questions based on the speeches, table topics and evaluations. At the end of the evening, they ask the questions to see who was listening.

Before the meeting

Prepare a brief introduction to the Quizmaster role. As a beginner you can simply read the intro block above.

During the meeting

When introduced, **explain** the purpose of the Quizmaster role

Throughout the meeting, **listen** carefully to each participating member and **record** interesting statements, facts or use of language.

When called upon at the end of the meeting, **ask** a selection of the questions you've prepared to test everyone's listening skills.
